

Nightlife

You have a lot of choices for nightlife in Tamarindo – there is usually at least one hot spot every night of the week. I would not recommend walking on the beach at night and after going out.

Babylon is an outdoor bar that has a Reggae night on Thursday and Ladies night on Saturday. A skate ramp, large screens with surf movies and tons of locals gives this place lots of flavor. It is a little sketchy getting there so keep aware. If you go to the end of Tamarindo Blvd., it turns into a cul de sac. On the side of the circle closest to the beach hug the buildings facing the beach and you will see an opening in the fence. Go through the yard and follow the music. There is a good mix of tourists and locals and once you find the place you will have fun.

La Barra is an open air bar on the main strip behind souvenir shops. It has an awesome Latin Night on Wednesdays with a live band.

Pasatiempo has a nice bar and an open mic night on Tuesdays unless the new owner has changed things. It is located up the hill on Calle Guanacaste.

The Monkey Bar at the Best Western Vista Villas gets a little crazy and cheesy but they have good music on Friday nights which is also ladies night.

Rey Sol is an after hours spot.

The Jazz Casino is a shabby little casino on the main road but they have Texas Hold'em, a few slot machines and a bar.
